DESCRIPTIVE REPORT OF REGULAR ACTIVITIES OF NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2015-16

NSS activities for the year 2015-16 began from the first week of July 2015. Enrolment of NSS continued till the end of August, 2015. Principal Dr.M.Z.Farooqui inaugurated the NSS activities on 1st August 2015.

Programme Officers:

Orientation Programme:

Power Point presentation, highlighting the regular activities and the residential camp. 200 NSS Volunteers participated in the event.

Tree plantation:

Elocution Competition, Debate on HIV/AIDS:

Poster Competition, on HIV/AIDS:

Save Electricity Project:

Initially under this project each volunteer adopted seven households and conducted the survey regarding the electricity bills and made aware them of the power shortage in the nation and consequences of using making excessive usage on supply of electricity and environment.

After the survey and talk they visited the respective households every month to assess the impact of talk.

After the end of the project volunteers prepared the reports and submitted to the NSS Unit of the College. Due to this initiative 2011 units of electricity could be saved.

Making and Distribution of Paper Bags and Note-Books:

Our 104 volunteers, from August, 2015 to January 2016 made more than 5000 paper bags and 983 note books in college the campus.

Paper bags were distributed to shopkeepers, vegetable and fish vendors and notebooks were distributed to BMC School of our community on 16th January, 2016. 72 volunteers participated in the event.
