

# **Detail Report of activities conducted Date Wise during the Academic Year 2012-13**

**Regular and Area Based Programmes:** Following programmes were conducted under the Regular and Area Based activities.

## **1. Tree plantation:**

- From 23<sup>rd</sup> of July to 24<sup>th</sup> of July 2012, 35 NSS volunteers participated in tree plantation, 13 trees were planted at cater road. All our core committee members participated in the event.

## **2. Making of paper bags:**

- On 7<sup>th</sup> August 2012, the NSS volunteers participated in paper bags making.
- In the month of 10<sup>th</sup> October, 15<sup>th</sup> October, 24<sup>th</sup> October, 25<sup>th</sup> October, 26<sup>th</sup> October, and 28<sup>th</sup> October 2012. All the NSS volunteers had participated in paper bag making. They made 3000 paper bags and distributed to the nearby shops.

## **3. HIV/AIDS awareness:**

- On 17<sup>th</sup> August 2012, 30 NSS volunteers participated in HIV/AIDS street play.
- On 1st December 2012, the NSS volunteers participated in the Lecture on HIV/AIDS in the college.
- On 1<sup>st</sup> December 2012, 40 NSS volunteers participated in Rally conducted from Ambedkar College to MDACs on HIV/AIDS awareness.

## **4. Cleanliness:**

- On 18<sup>th</sup> August 2012, 25 NSS volunteers participated in street play on cleanliness.
- On 11<sup>th</sup> December and 18<sup>th</sup> December 2012, 75 NSS volunteers participated in cleanliness of Sea shore at cater road.

## **5. Orientation Programme:**

- On 28<sup>th</sup> of July 2012, an orientation programme was conducted and our college principal Dr MZ. Farooqui inaugurated orientation programme. Programme officer, Prof. Paul R.P. showed a PowerPoint presentation highlighting our regular activities and the residential camp.
