

NOTICE: ON GENERIC ELECTIVE COURSE (GEC) ALLOTMENT

A second list of allotment of GE courses is being put up for students who applied after the last date. This list is an addition to the first list. A comprehensive final list for all students will be put up in February.

A timetable for GE course is also being put up, though there may be some changes in room numbers subsequently.

Students who still find their names missing or haven't yet applied or want to change their GE Course or have any other issues regarding GE allotment (for example mistake in name or roll number) may write to the following e-mail id, properly specifying their request or complaint.

Applicants please note:

- **The above is a different e-mail id from the one used last semester. Do not send mails to the earlier id.**
- **Write your full name (as in college record), roll number, class, and mobile number in the text of the mail.**
- **Provide your own mobile number and mail from your personal e-mail id, as far as possible.**
- **Clearly specify whether the application is for a change or first allotment of GE course. In case it is a request for change of GEC, please clearly specify the course from and to which the change is being requested for. In case it is an application for first allotment, please give 3 choices in order of preference.**

The students should also note that there were some errors in the form and also in the first list put up whereby wrong course titles were mentioned for a few subjects. Any student wishing to change the allotted GE due to this reason may do so through the above-mentioned procedure. Please note the correct course titles are given in the second course allocation list (put up today). Particularly note the correct course titles for the following courses:

GE Sem II: ENGLISH: Comic Books and Graphic Novels

GE Sem II: HISTORY: Issues in the Contemporary World: 1945 – 2000

GE Sem II: PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Aerobic Training

GE Sem IV: CHEMISTRY: Molecules of life

The last date for GE course changes is 31 January 2020. The request for a change in course will be accepted if there are seats available in the desired course. A student **should not**, therefore, automatically assume a change in course by merely applying for it.
